


How to Connect to eduroam network using Mac

Requirements:


1. An eduroam account from SNO or DIC.
2. An eduroam server to connect to.

Connect to eduroam network using Mac


1. Download eduroam installer through the eduroam Configuration Assistant Tool [here](#).




2. Choose **University of the Philippines Baguio** from the list of organizations.




3. Click **eduroam** to download.




4. Once downloaded, go to **System Settings > Privacy & Security**. Scroll down to **Profiles**.




5. Select **eduroam**.




6. It will ask if you want to install eduroam. Click **Install**.




7. Enter your username + @upb.edu.ph and password. Click **Install**.



8. Next, enter your Mac password to continue installation.



9. After installing eduroam, select **eduroam** from the list of Wi-Fi networks to connect.



10. You should now be connected to eduroam.
