

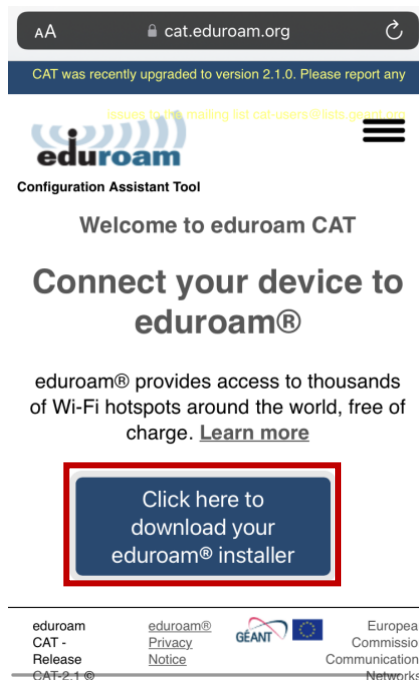
How to Connect to eduroam network using iOS

Requirements:

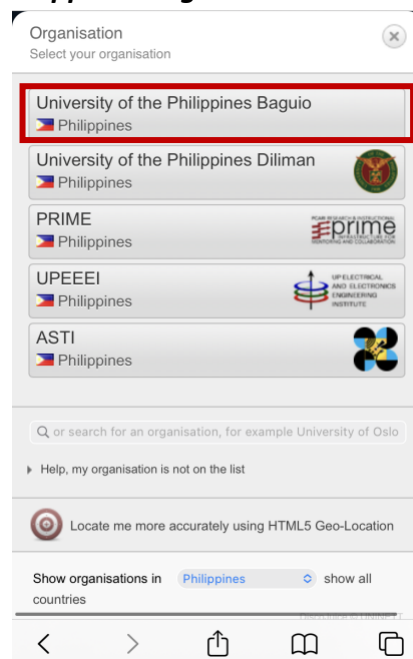
1. An eduroam account from SNO or DIC.
2. An eduroam server to connect to.

Connect using iOS

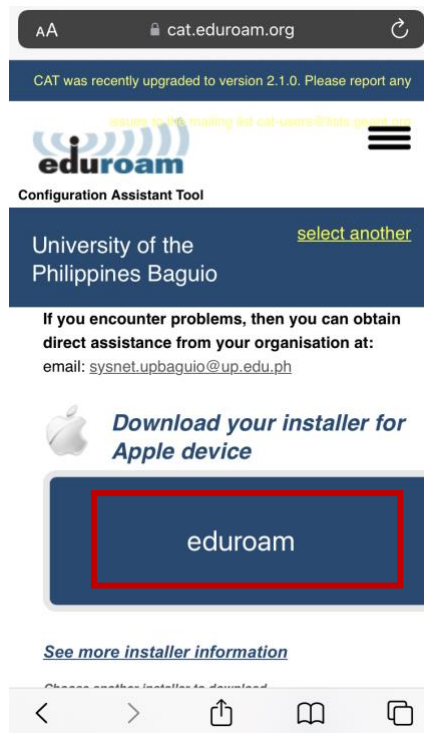
1. Download eduroam installer through the eduroam Configuration Assistant Tool [here](#).



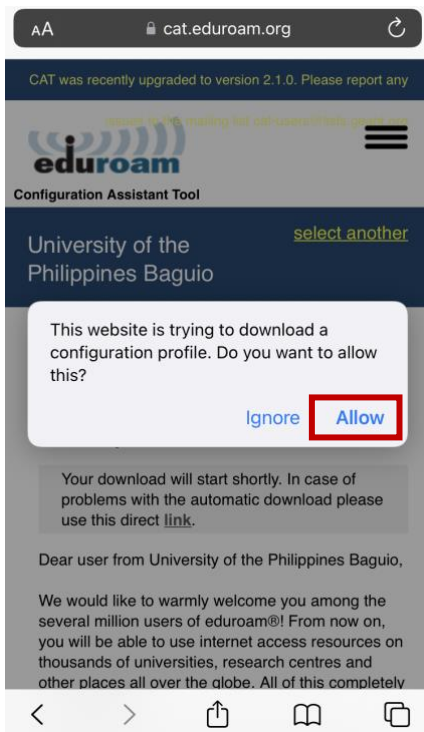
2. Choose **University of the Philippines Baguio** from the list of organizations.



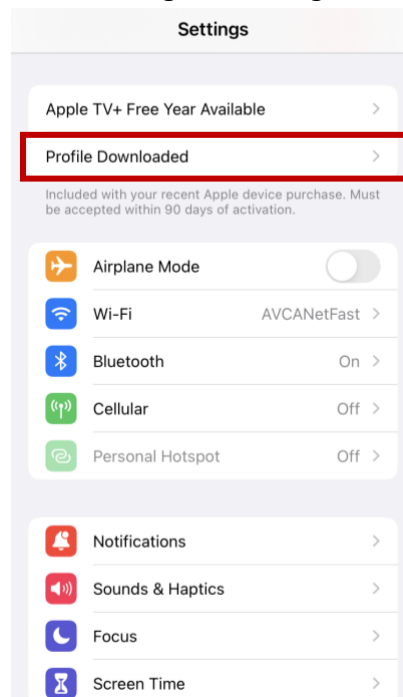
3. Tap **eduroam** to download.



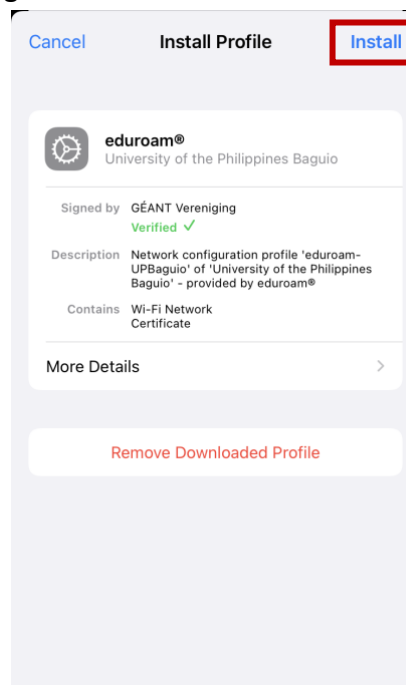
4. Tap **Allow** to allow to proceed with the download.



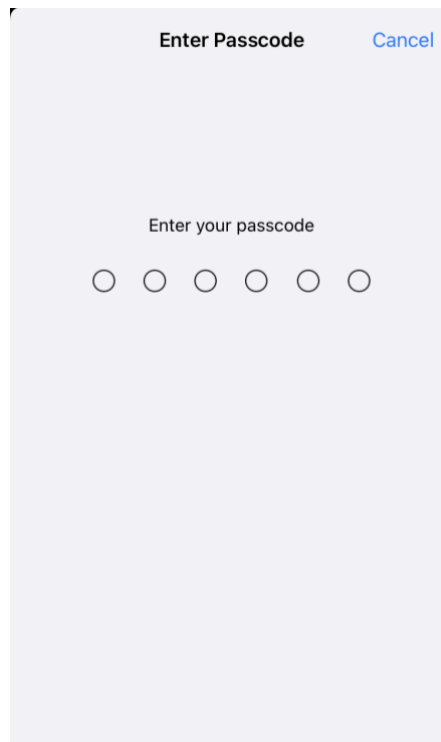
5. Once eduroam has been downloaded, go to *Settings* then tap **Profile Downloaded**.



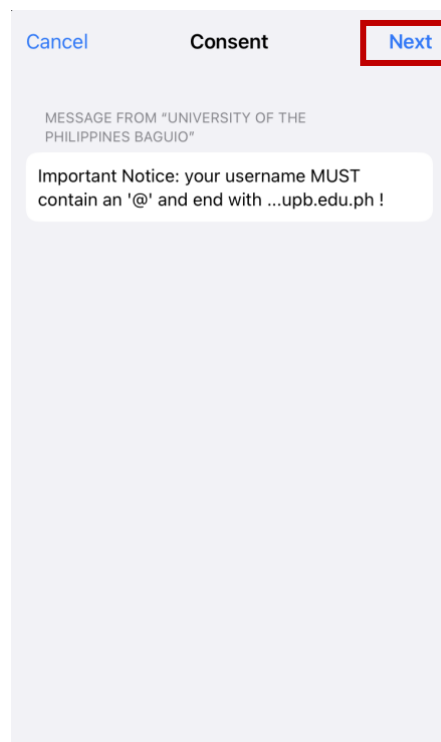
6. Tap **Install** on the upper-right corner of the screen to install the profile.



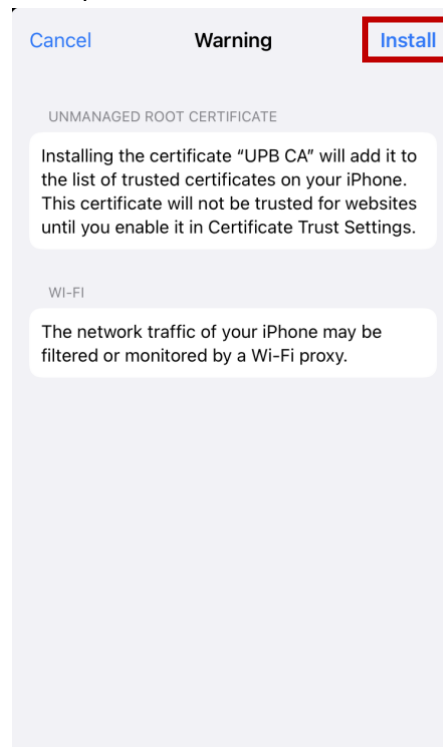
7. Enter your phone's passcode to continue.



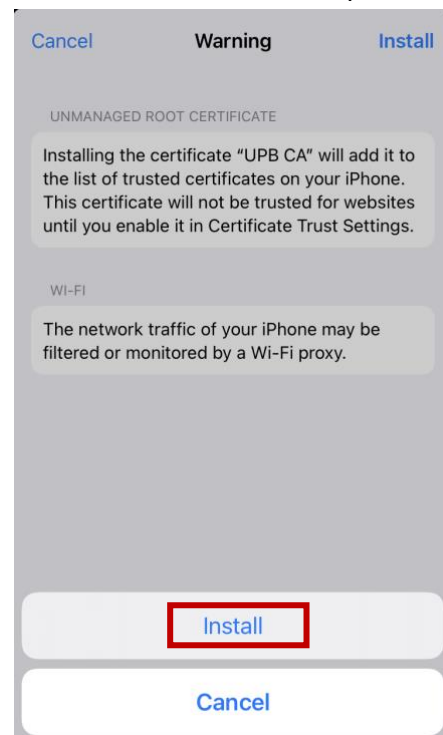
8. A notice will appear. Tap **Next** to continue.



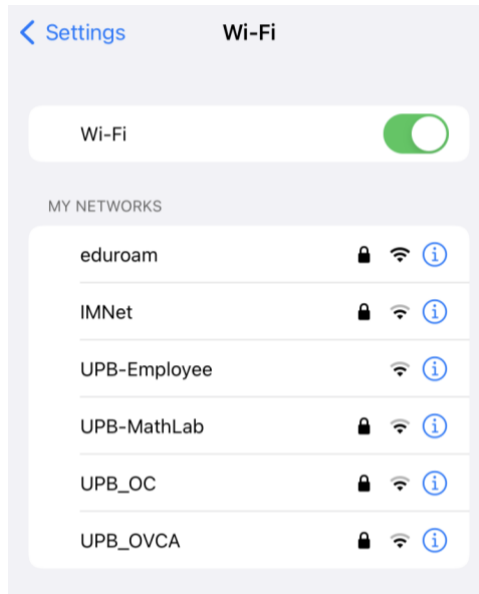
9. Next, a warning will appear. Tap **Install**.



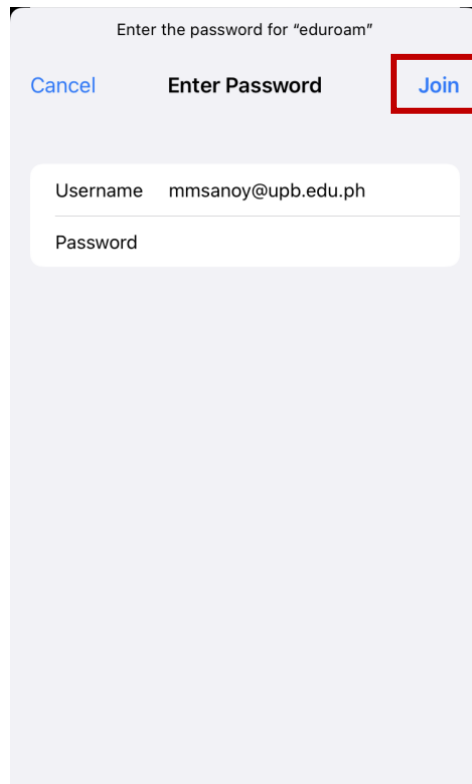
10. Tap **Install** again. Tap **Done** once installation is complete.



11. After installing eduroam, choose **eduroam** from the list of Wi-Fi networks.



12. Type your username + @upb.edu.ph and password then tap **Join**.



13. You should now be connected to eduroam.
