How to Connect to eduroam network using Android

Requirements:

- 1. An eduroam account from SNO or DIC.
- 2. An eduroam server to connect to.

Connect using Android

1. From the list of Wi-Fi networks, select *eduroam*.



2. Enter your username and password under *Identity* and *Password*.



3. Tap CA Certificate and choose *Don't Validate* from the list of options. Tap *View more*.



4. Choose PAP for *Phase 2 authentication* then type *anonymous@upb.edu.ph* on *Anonymous identity*. Finally, tap *Connect*.
