

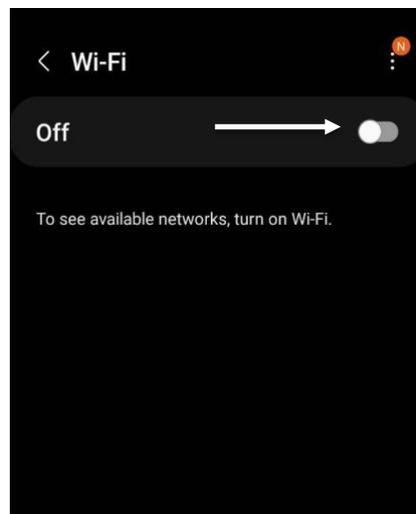
How to connect devices for Wi-Fi roaming inside UPB campus buildings

Requirements:

1. A device registered with the Systems and Network Office
2. Assigned SSID:
 - a. **UPB-Faculty** - device registered under faculty members
 - b. **UPB-Employee** - device registered under administrative staff and REPS
 - c. **UPB-Student** - device registered under UP Baguio students
 - d. **UPB-Guest** - all registered devices

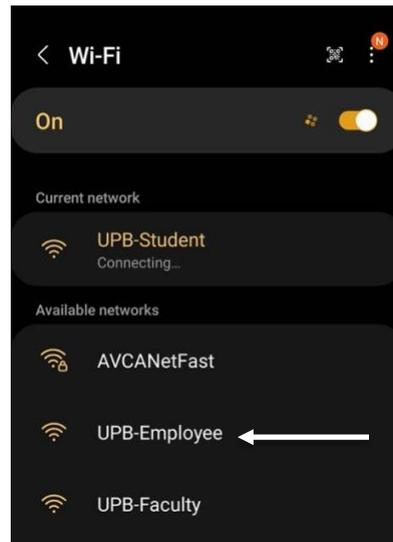
Connect using Android

1. Open the Wi-Fi Settings of your device then swipe the button to the right to turn on Wi-Fi connection.

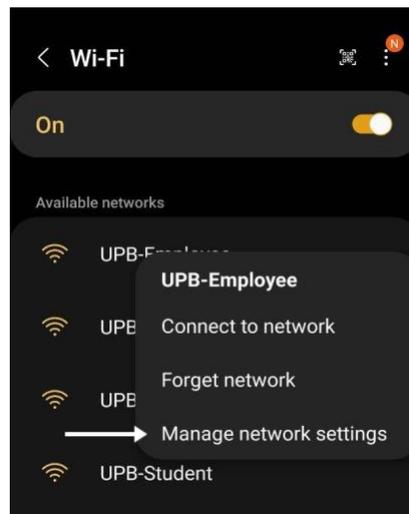


2. After turning on Wi-Fi, a list of available networks will appear. Locate your assigned SSID from this list. (Refer to the list of assigned SSID above.)

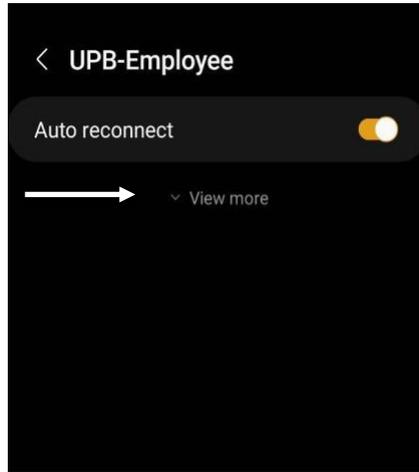
Note: If you don't see your assigned SSID, refresh your Wi-Fi by swiping down or by repeating Step 1.



3. Hold-tap your assigned SSID and select **Manage network settings** or **Modify Network**.

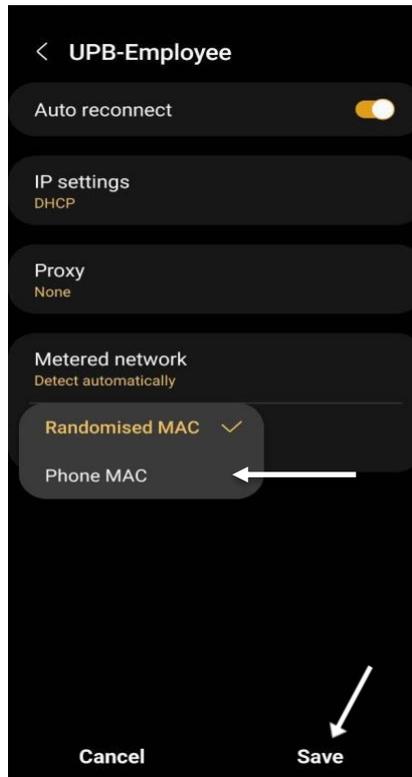


4. Click **View more** or **Advanced** or **Privacy** just below *Auto reconnect* to reveal all network settings. After clicking this, **MAC Address Type** should appear.



- Once **MAC Address Type** is shown, click it to display two options: **Randomised MAC** and **Phone MAC** or **Device MAC**. Select **Phone MAC/Device MAC** then click **Save** located at the bottom of the screen. Your device will now attempt to connect.

Note: If it doesn't connect, click the arrow on top of the screen to go back then select the assigned SSID again.



- Once it successfully connects, it should show the word *Connected* below the SSID.
